ENP Scholarship Application**

Purpose of ENP Certification

Professional certification is used to establish benchmarks of performance that signify a broad based competency in the professional arena. By successfully completing the ENP certification, you will:

1. Demonstrate a mastery of the comprehensive knowledge base required for emergency number program management.
2. Help raise industry standards and increase the respect and prestige of those involved in 9-1-1.
3. Confirm your commitment to the 9-1-1 profession by showing you are a leader in public safety.

Purpose of the Texas ENP Scholarship

1. To assist public safety professionals in reaching a higher level of knowledge of 9-1-1.
2. To provide financial assistance to Texas 9-1-1 professionals who might otherwise be unable to pursue ENP certification.

Criteria

1. The applicant must meet the NENA eligibility requirements for taking the exam and be seeking ENP Certification for the State of Texas.
2. The applicant must be employed on a full-time basis by a public safety agency, 9-1-1 administrative organization, or official 9-1-1 planning board.
3. The applicant must not have received any Texas NENA scholarship in the previous program year.

Scholarship Award

1. One scholarship will be awarded in each of the six Texas NENA regions.
2. Award will be based on but not limited to:
 - a. Applicant's participation as a Texas NENA member.
 - b. Applicant's years in 9-1-1 service.

The ENP Scholarship Committee has final responsibility for determining the scholarship recipient for each region.

Responsibilities of Scholarship Recipients

Scholarship recipients must be able to sit for the electronic exam testing. In the event that the recipient does not pass the exam, recipient understands that he or she will be responsible for re-examination fee at a cost of \$150.00.

Application Deadline

The ENP Scholarship Committee must receive scholarship applications by March 17, 2017. Scholarship recipients will receive notification of their selection at the Texas NENA Conference. Recipients have one year to redeem the ENP Scholarship.
